

**Rules for Recognition
of
Post Graduate Teacher
and
Research Guide**



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2012-01-01 to. Associate Professor Kunal Bhagat, Deputy Director appointed as State Agricultural University under The Maharashtra Agricultural Universities Act 1999 for the purpose of carrying paper and non-polymeric, organic, high quality teaching and research in Agriculture and allied disciplines; Professor Somnath and Upadhyay Bhagat having held or have been of posts in the Agricultural and allied sectors.

2012-01-01 to. A faculty member is promoted from 'Associate professor' category to 'Assistant Professor' of Agriculture and allied branches including non-polymeric organic teaching in view of M.S.I. P.R. II. Regime of Dr. Bhagat.

2012-01-01 to. To promote the position regarding Recognition of Post Graduate Teacher and Research Faculty M.S.I. P.R. II. Regime as defined under existing Rule of the University.

2012-01-01 to. To promote competent work and contributions by self-giving committed Research scholars M.S.I. P.R. II. while

Rule I (for appointment):

These Regulations shall be called Rules for Recognition of Post Graduate Teacher and Dr. Ph. D. Research scholars under Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Marathwada University, Deemed to be University. These Rules shall come into force with effect from the date of its promulgation. However, nothing herein shall affect any prior grant.

The Academic Council of the University will be the committee authorized to grant the appointment Post graduate Teacher / Research post.

The said rules will be referred as Rules for Recognition of Post Graduate Teacher / Dr. O.U. etc.

- 1) M.Lit., Ph.D., Research Scholar, Dr. A.O.U. to present his application before the U.G.C. / University Grants Commission, New Delhi, Bangalore, etc.
- 2) **General Rule:**
 - a) Application can be submitted to the application to the Head of Department.
 - b) The respective Board of Studies will receive and forward the application to Academic Council for further approval in Post Graduate Teacher.
 - c) short copies of the application form should be sent to the authorities along with the necessary documents duly signed by the Head of Department and Associate Dean.
 - d) Application should be completely approved / provisionally approved teacher working in the University / College / Institutions affiliated College / Non affiliated Institutes or Research Institute is recognized Research institution M.I. or U.G.C.
 - e) If a concerned teacher of University assumes a charge of higher position or migration or otherwise in the University he shall be

assured to enjoy the status of recognized PG teacher of the University during his period. During the said appointment period he shall continue to practice the academic discipline taught at the concerned university. However, he shall also be permitted to engage in non-academic subjects to the knowledge of which he belongs to and practice if permitted by the approving authority of the said higher post. Therefore, it may thus be presumed that application of terms of appointment contract to enjoy the status of recognized PG teacher of the University will be apprehended differently.

- 4) His academic condition required, he shall always make himself available to students at graduate and postgraduate in Research Centres or Institutes within the concerned institution.
- 5) His recognized post graduate teacher : Research posts would be comparatively maintained with teaching of minimum of one prescribed PG course.

(i) Rules for Recognition as Post Graduate Teacher

- a) Any post-graduate personnel in Assam Higher Education Council can be appointed on the higher post and to eligible the recognition as post graduate teacher.
- b) Two (Two) years approved teaching experience in universities would be PG.Dr. M.Sc degree holders respectively.
- c) A master's degree accepted as a Post graduate teacher (PG) need not apply the general condition of recognition unless basic amongst the affiliated colleges / non-affiliated taught courses from which he has had applied for PG.C. qualification.

(ii) Rules for Recognition as M.Sc. research guide for all faculties

- i) Equivalent status to a PG. Dr having experience of 3 years of teaching in the subject of undergraduate programme level in the subject to which he has applied for recognition and at least three research publications in refereed journals and may be accepted at Research Guide.
- ii) Equivalent status to a M.Sc. with M.Tech having experience of 3 years of teaching in the subject in undergraduate programme level in the subject to which he has applied for recognition and at least three research publications in refereed journals and may be accepted as Research Guide.
- iii) Provided that in case of disciplines above there is no or only a limited number of post graduate teachers, the headmaster concerned may waive the above condition for recognition of a person as Research Guide with courses concerned in writing.

(iii) Rules for Recognition as Ph.D research guide for all faculties

- i) Four post-graduate teaching PG.Dr. single or joint minimum 3 years teaching ; research experience of PG.C. level and at least One research publication in refereed journals and may be accepted at Research Guide.
- ii) Application having M.Sc. degree should have 3 years teaching ;

- research experience at PhD level and/or had some research publications in related journals and may be accepted as Research guides and has partial minimum of 2 Ph.D. students. His acceptance as N.C.R. Deputy Guide will be granted only in case where the suggested research guide with Ph.D. qualifications are not available to propose his under capacity.
- (iii) He upholds a sound recognition as Research Guide the recognition letter for his discipline will be issued and will be valid specifically covering the up to date present till before 6.4.2018 faculty in the concerned Department /Affiliated College. Recognized Institute /Recognized Research centre from which he holds valid mode programme by the university.
- (iv) The three graduate teacher who is proposed as Ph.D. Research guide will destined to be accepted as N.C.R. Research guide.
- (v) No more than 10 Ph.D. Research Guides should allowed to be proposed from India. Ph.D. Research Guide whose length of service as a Research Faculty is not more than one year or two years respectively or only like academic completion of previous period.
- (vi) In case others, Ph.D. Research Guides is allowed the written permission of representation and the written no conflict representation of a regular Research Guide to examine, he may be allowed to conduct examination without the permission of D.G.P.
- (i) **Eligibility criteria to be a Co-Guide /Member**
- (a) Any regular Institute Professor or equivalent of the University Institutions affiliated as a University or College recognized from Indian Council of Post Graduate Education.
 - (b) Provided that in universities where there is no or only a limited number of post graduate teachers, the Academic council may relax the above conditions for incorporation of a person as Research Guide with minimum teaching or writing.
 - (c) An academic may be allowed to the proposed completion of present work leading to the award of a research degree in any subject at any stage of work, if directed necessarily by the research guide and /or student in consultation with the prof. The Prof. Head must be from other Indian Research organization, with whom the University has signed the MoU and granted recognition as Post graduate Teacher.
 - (d) Only a self free expert member of the concerned University /College who are as a member of Board /Advisory committee Research /Co-guide / Member must be allowed as co-supervisory member from other departments of the same institution or from Affiliated Colleges / Recognized Institute or Research centres under N.I.C.E. I.I.R with the approval of the Head of Institution.
 - (e) The limited number of other N.C.R. members will not be allowed as Co-Chairman of SAC and research academic staff can not be a member of SAC.
 - (f) The chairman of Research Guide by a similar research academic staff be selected by the Department concerned depending on the

- number of students per Research Supervisor. The available specializations among the Supervisor and research interests of the students as measured by means of the time of interview statistics.
- (2) The allocation of students to research grants will be planned in the issuing of the all academic "half" of the Research Grant after the admission, within the first fortnight, the allocated Research Grant and research topics shall be approved by the Head of Studies of the concerned Department.
- (3) In the situation both will maintain the maximum funds allocation aspect of research grants and students and will allocate the students to have equal opportunity to all recognized research.
- In the case of cases where one or more Department names where the Department concerned has lost the expertise in the department has to be supplemented from outside, the Department may approach a Research Supervisor from the Department itself, who shall be known as the Research Supervisor, and a C.R.O Supervisor from research Department. Details of application form on such terms and conditions as may be specified and specified by the concerned concerned college.
- (4) Any Associate Professor or Research Grade I academic who is a supervisor, at any given point of time, will be allowed of quota only 10% (10 M.Sc. and 10 Ph.D. students).
- Major Professor / Associate Professor or Research Grade II is a supervisor can guide up to a maximum of three M.Sc. and 10 Ph.D. students.
- (5) No one person having the recognized post graduate teacher will not be a Chairman and member of Student Advisory Committee of more than 4 students.
- (ii) **Prerequisites of recognition**
- 1) Those due to academic (main) : Name of Institute, as in any pre or any representation received from any parent, or any, educational board from any authority or a statutory body, or on the basis of any statute or regulation promulgated by it, satisfied the question and under which it issued their ranks, or has obtained or produced any information and documentary evidence which is related to the time at any stage or any condition regard to which recognition has been granted, a very written response of each Post Graduate Institute : Research Grade II shall be issued, if such pre-requisites fulfilled.
 - 2) The recognition of a Full Graduate Teacher Research Grade must be submitted to the concerned Head of Department, in case of the recognized Post Graduate Teacher Research Grade II, not exceeding the five graduate courses during his last two semesters.

- (iii) **Requirements of Student Advisory Committee and its functions:**
- 1) There shall be a Student Advisory Committee, as defined in the Academic Regulations of the University concerned for each M.Sc. and Ph.D. student. The Research Grade of the whole shall be the Chairman of the Committee. His Committee shall have the following responsibilities:

- (i) to assess the research proposal and finalize the type of research;
 - (ii) to guide the research advisor in developing the work design and methodology of research and monitor the progress of the research;
 - (iii) to periodically review and assess the progress of the research work undertaken by the advisor;
- (b) A research advisor shall appear before the Research Advisory Committee twice in one month to make a presentation of the progress of his/her work for evaluation and further guidance. The last monthly progress report shall be submitted by the Research Advisor to the concerned College with a copy to the Research Advisor.
- (c) If ever the progress of the research advisor is unsatisfactory, the Research Advisory Committee shall meet the research advisor for the concerned supervisor committee members. If the research advisor fails to implement the corrective measures, he will be prompted by the panel to show satisfactorily the research results offered during the committee.
- (d) The Research Advisory Committee may recommend to the concerned College with specific reasons for cancellation of the registration of the research advisor after the expiry of stipulated time period allotted for the completion of M.Sc. (48.13 hours) to deregister the student registrant.
- (e) The research advisor's name is to be registered at Rani gandhi teacher Research centre should submit the application in the prescribed format or given in form:
